

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING
SETTING OF FINAL TAX REQUEST

The proposed tax levy request rates include: LCC General Fund at 0.648570, LCC Special Building Fund at 0.001072 and Laurel-Concord Public School Qualified Capital Purpose Undertaking Fund K-12 at 0.014774.
